

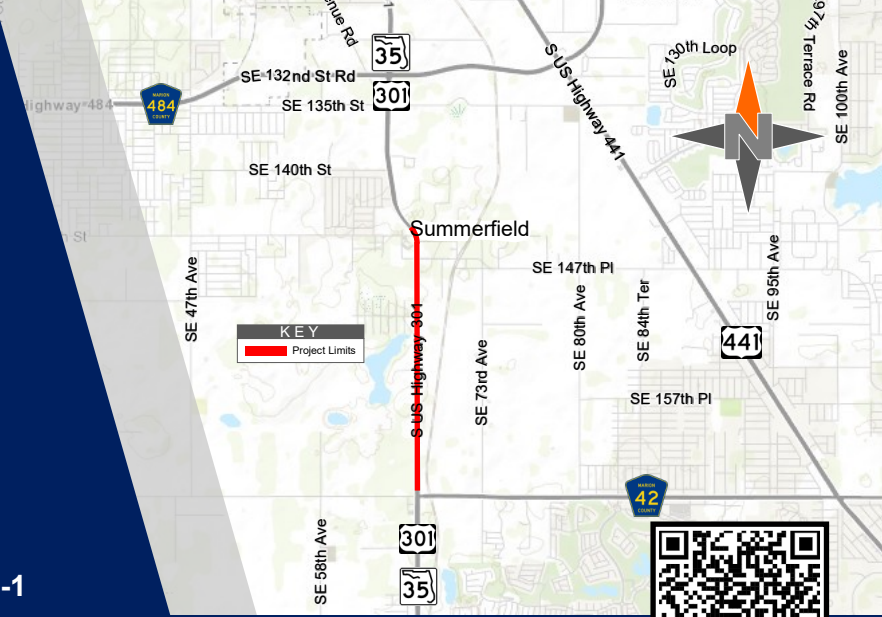


U.S. 301 Resurfacing

From north of C.R. 42 to north of SE 144th Place Road

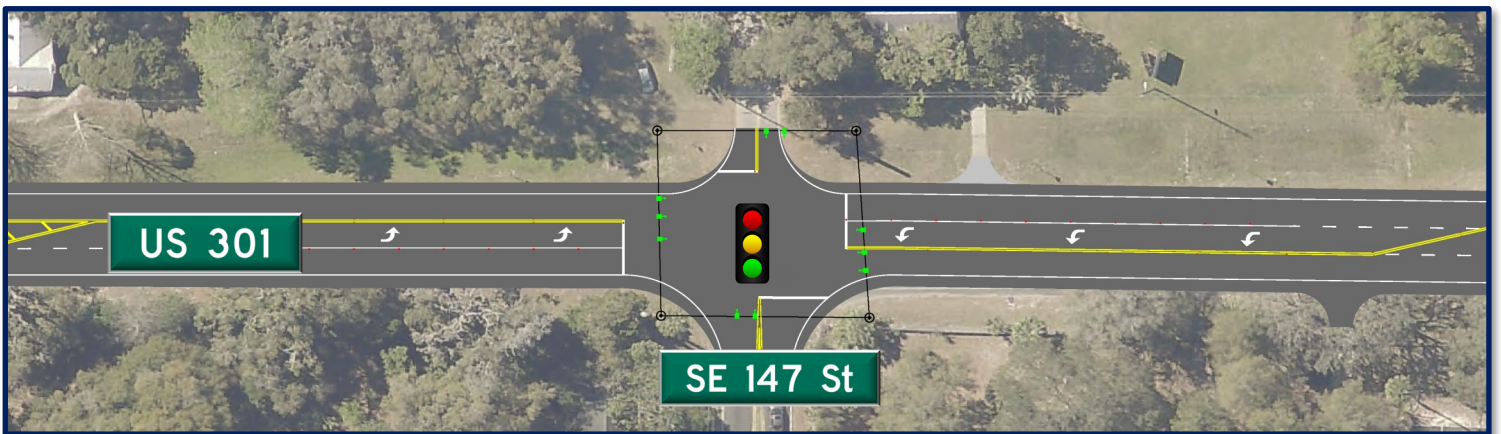


Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning operational and safety improvements along U.S. 301 from north of County Road (C.R.) 42 to north of SE 144th Place Road. The primary focus of the project is to resurface this 2.2-mile segment of U.S. 301 to extend the life of the existing roadway.

Additionally, the project plans safety and operational improvements, including constructing a new traffic signal at the intersection of U.S. 301 and SE 147th Street. Other work includes upgrading drainage as needed, improving shoulders and providing bicycle through lanes next to right turn lanes (also known as key holes) in two locations. The project will also upgrade guardrail, enhance lighting, and enhance signing and pavement markings along the corridor.

U.S. 301 is a designated evacuation route. The project limits include two-lane and four-lane sections with posted speed limits ranging from 40 mph to 55 mph.
