



S.R. 11 Improvements Project

from Volusia County Line to U.S. 1

Flagler County

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing improvements on State Road (S.R.) 11 from the Volusia County line to U.S. 1 in Bunnell. The more than 15-mile project plans to repave S.R. 11 throughout the corridor. At the north end of the project, FDOT recommends extending the curb in some areas to create alignment shifts, or chicanes, which help to encourage slower driving speeds.

Additional pedestrian safety measures include raised crosswalks (see rendering) with Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacons, or RRFBs, and new street lighting. The project also proposes to reduce the travel lane width to 11 feet and create additional space for a northbound sidewalk from Forsyth Lane to the existing sidewalk at Railroad Street. A shared-use path is being considered on the northbound side of S.R. 11 from Old Haw Creek Road to Forsyth Lane. Shared bicycle lanes are also being proposed within the City of Bunnell from Forsyth Lane to U.S. 1.

This project will be constructed with intersection improvements at S.R. 11 and C.R. 304 (FPID No. 439156-1). FDOT is proposing a roundabout at the intersection to enhance traffic operations and safety.
